- be accountable for developing and implementing the People and Culture strategy for the Council, and for collaborating with the CCOs.
- ensure alignment with the Group Services Directorate as well as the overall Council strategy, and build an action oriented, high-performance culture.
- be drawn to and motivated by the impact of the Council's activities for all Aucklanders.
